Churches Together in Rustington - Lent House Groups 2018

The annual series of ecumenical Lent Reflection groups will begin on Monday 19th February 2018. There will be 8 groups spread across Monday to Thursday each week, over a five-week period (the groups do not meet in Holy Week). This year two themes are offered:

(1) the York Course material on the theme of 'On the Third Day' which will focus on the Resurrection

(2) 'Calling People of Goodwill: The Bible and the Common Good' - materials created by Together for the Common Good and the Bible Society

Each Group Leader has chosen the theme. There will be a small charge towards the cost of the materials which will be subsidised by CTR. The maximum number for each house group is 8 people (including host & leader), and up to 12 people at the Church group. More details are available on the notice board in church. If you are interested in joining one of these groups, alongside Christians from other churches, please sign up on the sheet at the back of the church. The co-ordinating group will do their best to allocate your first choice, but with limited spaces it is not always possible, so please indicate a second choice. The closing date for sign up is **Sunday 28th January**, so book early to avoid disappointment.

Diocese of Chichester YEAR OF PRAYER 2018 Lent Course:

Inspiring Vision

- The course considers how the visual arts provide inspiration and pathways to prayer.
- The Archbishop of Canterbury and Dame Patricia Routledge are amongst the guest contributors.
- The Trinity, Challenging Times, Discipleship, Prayers of Praise, Prayers as Life Evolves, and the Experience of Forgiveness are all explored across 6 weeks of reflection, discussion and listening.

Each week, Lent groups and individuals are invited to reflect on the chosen painting by listening to a specially produced podcast (c. 15 minutes) in which the guest explains the significance to them personally of the chosen work. But in so doing, the guests raise questions for all of us about our own prayer life and how our prayers develop as we mature, journey on our pilgrimage and discover more about the divine mystery as God speaks to us in good times and bad. An accompanying set of notes for each session suggest Scripture readings and exercises for us in response to what we see and hear. These resources are all available for download via the Diocesan website, or can be ordered to print through the Diocesan online shop. By the end of the six weeks the hope is that each participant's focus on their own prayer life will have been invigorated and challenged as a key aspect of our Year of Prayer. It would be good if we can provide the additional opportunity this course affords in which people can participate during Lent. More on this in due course ... ZA
