Pantry: This week's Pantry session was buzzing, with 74 households collecting food. We're so grateful to our wonderful volunteers, whose kindness and care make such a difference in welcoming and supporting everyone who comes through our doors. The church was open for tea, coffee, and cake, offering a warm space for conversation and connection. Many of our visitors value the chance to find friendship and a safe place to belong, and we are blessed to be able to provide that. At the same time, we ran our Money Coaching Course for Pantry users. We've offered this course before, and the feedback has always been incredibly positive. It's a brilliant way to help people take control of their finances, rather than feeling controlled by them. We're pleased to share that the course will run again in the Spring. If you're able to donate, we are currently short of: cereals, toilet rolls, tinned ravioli, tinned potatoes, and tuna. Thank you for your generosity.
